



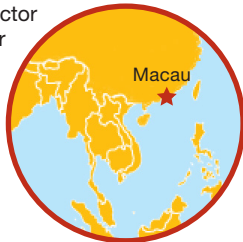

David and Barbara Bush serve the Lord through The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) as career missionaries in Macau. David serves as the director of the Concordia English Center in Macau. As the Center's director, he supervises and creates curriculum and oversees the staff and enables them so they are able to be as effective as possible. He also works to raise funds for the Center and its programs. In addition to these duties, David provides guidance and assistance to the Macau Lutheran Deaf Outreach.

David was born in Tecumseh, Mich. He earned a bachelor's degree in English and elementary education from Concordia Teachers College, River Forest, Ill., and his Master of Divinity degree from Concordia Theological Seminary (CTS), Fort Wayne, Ind. He has completed coursework at CTS toward his Doctor of Ministry degree. Prior to serving in Macau, David served as a pastor and missionary to the deaf in several Midwest LCMS congregations, as well as a base chaplain in the Air National Guard. Most recently, he was an interpreter and Bible class leader at Zion Lutheran Church, Marshall, Mich. In his free time, David enjoys reading, woodworking, gardening, hiking and leather carving.



Barbara was born in Bay Shore, N.Y. She earned a bachelor's degree in physical education from Gallaudet University, Washington, D.C. Before becoming a missionary, she worked at Bethesda Lutheran Communities, Fort Wayne, Ind., caring for clients in group homes. In her free time, Barbara likes to ride bicycles and read the Bible.

Pray for David and Barbara as they serve in Macau and transition to life in Asia, learning new languages (Cantonese language and Chinese sign language) and the culture. Pray for Barbara as she is deaf and is nervous about traveling (and living) outside of the United States for the first time. Any gifts received in excess of a worker's requirement for a given year are held for that worker until needed. Should a worker's service conclude for any reason, the funds remaining in the restricted account will be transferred to one or more eligible LCMS international workers who most closely fulfill the restrictions of the original gift. With documented donor permission, a restricted gift can also be utilized to support international work budgeted by the LCMS. Your gift is tax deductible to the extent permitted by law.
